Special Assessment Levy for Public Safety

Please take notice that a public hearing will be conducted by the Goodland Twp. Board at the Township Hall, located at 2374 N. Van Dyke Rd., Imlay City on the 26th day of June, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.

The purpose of the hearing will be to consider objections to the estimated costs and expenses for fire protection and on the distribution of the special assessment levy for the 2018-2019 fiscal year.

The special assessment district consists of the entire Township of Goodland, Lapeer County, Michigan. Appearance and protest at the hearing is required in order to appeal the amount of the special assessment to the Michigan Tax Tribunal.

Appearance and protest may be made by an owner, party in interest, or his/her agent (in writing or in person) at the hearing to protest special assessment filing. You may file a written appeal of the special assessment with the State Tax Tribunal within thirty (30) days after confirmation of the special assessment roll if the special assessment was protested at the hearing, held for the purpose of confirming the roll.

BURN PERMITS are issued with the understanding that "the fire shall be attended until fully extinguished." Burn Permits are issued for the purpose of burning ONLY natural products—tree limbs, branches, leaves, plant stubble, etc. *It is illegal to burn any type of construction material! The Board of Review will convene on December 12, 2017 from 5:00 pm until 7:00 pm to deal with clerical mistakes, mutual errors and principal residence exemptions. It will hold it's Organizational Meeting to receive the Roll from the Assessor on March 5, 2018 at 6:00 pm. The public meeting for property owners to check their 2018 Assessments will be held March 12, 2018 from 9:00 am until 5:00 pm and March 14, 2018 from 5:00 pm until 9:00 pm. There will be an additional Board of Review meeting on July 17, 2018 from 6:00 pm until 8:00 pm for principal residence exemptions. Poverty exemptions can be handled at any Board of Review meeting

Important Information For Taxpayers

- Reminder the 2017 Winter taxes—without interest and penalties—are due in full by February 14, 2018
- **The Treasurer's office will be open to accept year end payments from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm on Thursday, December 28, 2017.**
- February 14, 2018, is the last day to pay taxes without penalties and interest.
- Payments for 2017 Taxes will be accepted at the Township Hall through February 28, 2018
- Both the Township and County Treasurer accept partial payments.
