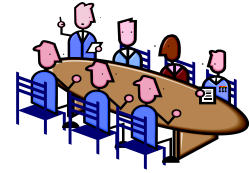

Important Information For Taxpayers



- Reminder the 2017 Summer Taxes—without interest and penalties—are due in full by **September 14, 2017**. This is the last day taxes are due and payable before interest is added under MCL211.44A. **Office hours that day will be from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm.**
- There is a drop box available on the pillar outside if the Treasurer/Deputy Treasurer is not in the office.
- The Treasurer's office is currently accepting applications for Summer 2017 Tax Deferments.
- The deferral applications can be found at: <https://accessmygov.com/?uid=628> or www.michigan.gov/taxes in property tax, or may be obtained at the Goodland Township Treasurer's Office; Louis J. Parsch, CPFA, MCPT, Treasurer; Michelle Noble, Deputy Treasurer .

You can get your **BURN PERMITS online!!! They easy and they are free!** www.goodlandtownship.org Burn Permits are issued with the understanding that "the fire shall be attended until fully extinguished." Burn Permits are issued for the purpose of burning **ONLY** natural products—tree limbs, branches, leaves, plant stubble, etc. *It is illegal to burn any type of construction material!*

PLEASE REMEMBER that your fire department is a volunteer/paid-on-call department. The fire hall is not staffed during any regular hours.
