14 The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Cischke at 6:30 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was
15 recited by all. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the gravel project and funding, blight issues,
16 ballot language, and the Flansburgh School project.

19 Motion by Juip, seconded by Tanis, to approve the agenda as presented.

22 Road Gravel Project—there was discussion regarding the roads to receive gravel this season. There was
23 also discussion regarding the costs of processing and the line of credit terms that are being used to fund
24 the project.

26 Cross Tubes—there was additional discussion regarding the large tube that can be funded through the
27 Lapeer County Bridge Fund and an additional tube at Turner & Wheeling Rds. Each will cost
28 approximately \$2200 from the Township. It was the consensus to wait until the next meeting for a
29 decision so that more information about the costs and status of the Gravel Project can be put together.

31 Blight Issues—the template letter was approved by the Attorney. He made some minor changes to
32 include portions of the State Law and Ordinance references. The letter is only to be sent after a complaint
33 has been received. No action was taken regarding the proposed ballot language regarding a millage for
34 Blight enforcement.

36 **Motion 07-16-11TB**

37 Motion by Juip, seconded by Parsch, to adopt the letter with changing that response is “required” not
38 “requested” and the time line from “14 days” to “30 days.” Additionally, the letter should be from the
39 Goodland Township Board.

43 Flansburgh School Agreement—there was discussion regarding the terms of the Agreement. Juip would
44 like to discuss the Agreement with Rubenstein.
