29 above; the Treasurer’s Report ending February 28, 2019; Library Fund prior disbursements of \$1,167.90;  
30 General Fund prior disbursements of \$1,081.94; Public Safety expenses of \$3,376.47; Library Fund  
31 expenses of \$1,654.86; and General Fund expenses of \$14,974.77 (which includes the above \$2,000).

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1 LCRC—there are bids for several tubes that need to be replaced and Bowers Rd ditching needs to be  
2 discussed at the next meeting. There was also discussion of another millage request for the Township  
3 for roads.

5 Motion by Parsch, seconded by Tanis, to approve the application of brine to township roads at a cost not  
6 to exceed \$16,717.80 and to pay half using allocations.

7 **MOTION CARRIED.**

8 CCA—1 permit was issued for a solar unit. EMS/Goodland Community Church would like to talk to  
9 someone regarding a sign at the Church.

10 LCEMS—looked at 2 new rigs. Their millage will be back on the 2020 ballot, but are hoping at a reduced  
11 rate.
