A Special meeting of the Goodland Township Board was held at the Goodland Township Hall, located at 2374 N Van Dyke Rd, Imlay City, MI 48444; pursuant to notice duly posted.

Supervisor Cischke called the meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. A moment of silence was held and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the Earthen Material Removal Ordinance, including Amendments (Ord. 801).

Pits on Clear Lake Rd, Summers Rd, and Muck Rd are all under the 801. Holtz, Ragatz, & Sisson pits were in existence prior to the 801 adoption. There was discussion about the process of pits under 801 for annual inspections and the fees paid quarterly by the ton to assist in reclamation. Prior pits have not been held to the standards of the 801.

It was the advice of the Attorney that 801 be updated. Also discussed was the need for addressing the hauling in of material and dumping in the pits.

There was discussion about how the prior pits need to be handled administratively to bring them in to compliance.

It was the consensus of the Board to have the Attorney write an opinion on how to handle the Holt pit sale and suggested updates to the Ordinance.
