Burn Permits are issued with the understanding that "the fire shall be attended until fully extinguished." Burn Permits are issued for the purpose of burning **ONLY** natural products—tree limbs, branches, leaves, plant stubble, etc. It is illegal to burn any type of construction material!

## Important Info For Taxpayers



- Reminder the 2022 Summer Taxes—without interest and penalties—are due in full by **September 14, 2022**. This is the last day taxes are due and payable before interest is added under MCL211.44A. **Office hours that day will be from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm.**
- **Please use the drop box that is available on the pillar outside or mail in your tax payments, if the Treasurer/Deputy Treasurer is not in the office.**
- **Summer Tax Receipts will be mailed out with the Winter receipts as in years previous.**
- The Treasurer's office is currently accepting applications for Summer 2022 Tax Deferrals.
